Don't forget to renew your Texas fishing license if you haven't already done so.

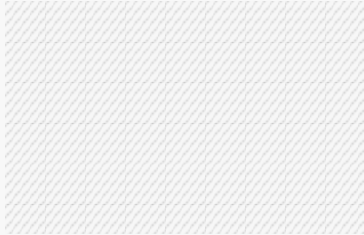
